Thank you all for participating in the fabulous virtual presentation of the CATS: National 3 "With Love, Now and Forever" fundraiser. Last Friday night's "opening night" was a delightful success.

Your feline cavalcade raised \$22,230 for Broadway Cares/Equity Fights AIDS in support of the good work being done at The Actors Fund. These funds are the total of on-line donations to the CATS: NATIONAL 3 landing page and to BC/EFA's YouTube channel over the event's four-day, on-line run. Bravo!

You are part of "a wave" that has allowed Broadway Cares over the last eight months to maintain an essential safety net of assistance and services for our friends, co-workers and loved ones across Broadway/NYC theatre community and indeed from coast to coast:

- 1) Since the shutdown began on March 12<sup>th</sup>, **Broadway Cares has raised and awarded The Actors Fund \$7.5 million**, specifically for their Emergency Financial Assistance outreach and a new health insurance initiative, Every Artist Insured.
- 2) In April, BC/EFA initiated a new online campaign entitled "Emergency Grants for Pandemic Relief that raised just over \$2 million specifically earmarked for more than 300 social service agencies across the country whose clients have nearly been overwhelmed by the pandemic.
- 3) In addition, \$909,000 in emergency assistance grants have been awarded to social service providers here in NYC, nearly overwhelmed with requests for help

You all are a part of the fabric of those efforts, as you have been from our earliest days.

The enthusiasm, generosity of spirit and joyful courage that you brought to the benefits presented in cities across the country by CATS 3 in the mid- '80's built the foundation in the Broadway community and on the road from which we work today. It's a rich, sweetly remembered legacy. For which all here at Broadway Cares are most grateful.

And here we are today, over 30 years later. Now and forever does not get better than this. Or ever better than you.

Special thanks to Jonathan Cerullo and his JSC Productions for leading the charge on this shining endeavor.

You have conjured the means for us to move into a New Year in strength and with a Jellicle re-commitment to good will and embracing those in crisis.
